The NZ Hospital Pharmacists' Association (NZHPA) Compounding Nutrition and Oncology (CNO) Special Interest Group are proud to offer a Parenteral Nutrition (PN) webinar series with Professor Emeritus Gil Hardy.

Professor Hardy has previously worked in the School of Pharmacy, University of Auckland and the College of Health at Massey University. He was a recipient of the American Society for Parenteral and Enteral Nutrition (ASPEN) Distinguished Nutrition Support International Service Award in 2014, the founder and first Chairman of the ASPEN International Clinical Nutrition Section, and is currently a member of the Board of Directors and an ASPEN Fellow. ASPEN's Fellows are outstanding leaders in nutrition support, consistently contributing in education, practice, research, and service to the field.

The webinars will be based on the ASPEN Best Practice in Parenteral Nutrition Training Program, with summarised lectures by expert pharmacist, dietitian and nurse members of ASPEN, but will include discussion of local practice. The webinars are kindly sponsored by Fresenius Kabi and Baxter Healthcare.

Each webinar will start at 7 p.m. on a Thursday evening and will run for 45-60 minutes.

The dates scheduled for the first 4 webinars are:

- October 15 and 29;
- November 19 and 26

Topics covered in these webinars will include:

- Reviewing and verifying the PN order;
- PN compounding and stability;
- PN administration

An additional two webinars are scheduled to be held in 2021, on:

- February 25 and March 11

Topics for these webinars will include:

- PN: When should it be used?
- Refeeding syndrome across the ages.
